

STATUTE OF THE "OMNIS" ASSOCIATION

Article 1 It is constituted, according to the art. 14 and following of the Civil Code the non-profit association called "OMNIS".

Article 2 - SEDE The Association is based in Via F.lli Cairoli, 24 06125 Perugia, and is a free association of administratively autonomous fact, regulated in accordance with the art. 18 of the Constitution and by the articles 36 and following of the Civil Code. Any change of venue within the same Municipality or Region does not imply any statutory variation.

Article 3 - OBJECT AND PURPOSE The Association is non-profit and is non-party.

1.The purposes of the Association are:

A) promote and support vocational training and professional education; promote and support cultural, professional, political, social, recreational and sporting activities aimed at the overall development of society;

B) to foster the creation of a network between people who perform different activities in the professional, cultural, social, political, in order to promote cooperation, the exchange of experiences, the enhancement of individual skills;

C) promote and carry out activities of experimentation, study, research, information and documentation in the field of training and career guidance, including, within the framework of national, regional and territorial development plans, the elaboration, study and implementation of projects of reconversion and industrial restructuring; the study and research, information and documentation relating to environmental development plans; carries out promotional, planning and organizational activities for the orientation of vocational training and in the field of school education;

promotes and coordinates all the research, training and exchange activities carried out by the ERS, the EU, the EEC and other international organizations; coordinate and care for the relations and regional bodies in the field of vocational training; coordinates, plans and carries out training activities for trainers and their updating in international, national and regional laws; coordinates and carries out training activities for qualified technicians in the field of the various technologies applied to the environment; coordinates, establishes and manages professional training centers and courses within the regional and national territory; handles relations with other Regional and National vocational training bodies; organizes events, conventions and congresses; participates in conferences, congresses, events related to the purposes of the association;

D) promote, implement and support training activities, seminars and conferences before and after graduation, for the development of issues, related to the legal profession, aimed at acquiring skills and abilities, especially practices, for the application of the right to life cases .

It is proposed the development of multidisciplinary skills, associating the traditional methods of the legal profession with the most modern defensive techniques and methods in the process of criminal law and in immigration law;

E) promote national and international cooperation initiatives in the field of equal opportunities;

F) support and organize training actions aimed at the promotion and orientation of female employment;

G) to relate with the institutions in order to implement the purposes contained in the laws, regulations and statutes of the institutions for the

promotion of equal opportunities;

H) to take care of and promote actions aimed at protecting weak people against any form of discrimination or abuse;

I) take care of the creation of a database of female skills in all fields: professional, political, social, cultural, artistic, recreational, literary, family;

Organizes and participates in conferences, congresses, events concerning

the purposes of the association and not only; takes care of the printing and

dissemination of educational and cultural material, as well as the publishing

of texts and handouts and newspapers and magazines useful for the

achievement of the statutory purposes; promote, encourage and support

volunteering, in all its forms and in all fields where it can operate; promote

initiatives to encourage the integration and integration of people from non-

EU countries, stateless persons and political refugees, present in Italy, in

social and work life in a position of equality with Italian citizens; create

branches also of legal assistance for non-EU citizens able to promote

initiatives aimed at improving the conditions of coexistence and solidarity

within local, inter-municipal and provincial communities, and of mastering

new individual social situations; The Association may promote, as such, or

in collaboration with public and private institutions and public bodies, both

initiatives and actions to improve the social and cultural status of immigrant

foreigners;

L) promote the cultural, sporting and professional training of young people and their inclusion in social life.

M) promote after-school activities (integrative post-school services),

educational and socio-cultural, DIAGNOSIS AND ADHD TREATMENT,

hyperactivity, attention deficit, DIAGNOSIS AND DSA TREATMENT,

dyslexia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, COGNITIVE ADDICTION, PSYCHOTHERAPY, LOGOPEDIA, RELATIONAL PSYCHOMOTRICITY; TRAINING and promotion for PARENTS and OPERATORS meetings.

N. Professional training activated by F.S.E. and from other national, international (including that of the Ministry of Education) and private bodies;

O. coordination and care in relations with institutional bodies in the field of vocational education and training;

P. coordinating, planning and carrying out training activities for trainers and their updating in the field of vocational education and training;

Q. to favor the creation of an institutional network (Schools, public and private bodies) that carry out different activities in education and profession,

R. To favor the creation of protocols and conventions between the various public and private institutions;

S) carry out experimentation, study, research, information and documentation on training and educational and vocational guidance,

T. Promote and organize seminars, conferences, congresses, events related to the purposes of the association;

U. To take care of the printing and dissemination of educational and cultural material, as well as the publishing of texts and handouts and newspapers and magazines useful for the achievement of the statutory purposes;

V. promoting and supporting volunteering, in all its forms and in all fields where it can operate;

Z. Promote and coordinate the establishment of local agencies and branches.

2. The Association can not carry out activities other than those indicated in

point 1 of this Article, with the exception of those directly connected and ancillary by nature. The activities described above can be carried out throughout Italy, also through the creation of secondary offices, agencies and branches other than those in the region where the main office is located.

Article 4 DURATION The duration of the Association is fixed in 30 (thirty) years from the date of its establishment.

Article 5 MEMBERS All the citizens who share their initiatives and approve the Bylaws can participate in the Association, which may be admitted as members, as supporters, ordinary or members.

Only the subscribers of the deed of incorporation are founding members.

Worthy members are all those to whom the Board of Directors, by reason of their activities and their commitment to the defense, dissemination and dissemination of the values and ideals of the Statute

Supporters are those who intend to support the Association's activities in a meaningful way.

Ordinary members are those who, by competence and activity, are able to contribute to the pursuit of the purposes of the Association.

Those members who have an interest in following the initiatives and activities are members who are not entitled to vote.

The application for registration of new members must be submitted to the Steering Committee which will decide at its sole discretion and without obligation to state reasons, whether to accept or reject the application itself and the status of member to be attributed to the applicant.

Article 6 Members, with the exception of those worthy, are required to pay the annual membership fee set by the Board of Directors. Article 7 The

Association consists of the following bodies: Assembly of members, Board of Directors, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Supervisory Body.

A) Assembly of members - The same have the right to participate all members in good standing with the payment of the shares. The Assembly is ordinary to convene, by the Board of Directors, at least once a year it is extraordinary that is instead convened whenever the Governing Council deems it necessary. The assembly is validly constituted, whatever the number of members present, provided that there is evidence that all those entitled to participate have been regularly called. The call is valid even if it took place in the short streets and / or by mail, provided that it is timely to ensure the presence of the member in the Assembly.

The Shareholders' Meeting resolves by a majority of those with voting rights. Each member has the right to one vote, the proxy vote is allowed, in the amount of two (2) proxies for each delegate. The Assembly is usually chaired by the President or by a Deputy Chairman, with the help of the Secretary.

The Assembly carries out all the tasks that do not belong to the Board of Directors, which the Board of Directors itself gives it as well as those attributed to it by the Statute.

B) The Board of Directors - It has a duration of 5 years. For the first 5 years all the founding members will be part of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors is composed of an odd number of members that can not exceed number 5. Starting from the fifth year, the Assembly will provide for the appointment of the Directors who will constitute the Board and the number of those who compose it after self-candidature. The members of the Board are re-eligible. The Board is regularly constituted and validly deliberates if it

is composed of at least half of its advisers, provided that there is evidence that the others have been regularly warned and summoned. The convocation is valid even if it happened for the short streets and / or by mail, provided that in time to ensure the presence of the member to the Board.

Decades before the fifth year if half +1 of the members resign.

The Board of Directors directs the activity of the Association and is invested with the widest powers for the ordinary and extraordinary management of the same. The Board of Directors has the right to appoint working and research groups to facilitate the management and the activity of the Association.

The Board of Directors appoints the President, the Vice - President and the Secretaries.

The appointments are valid if the candidate obtains a simple majority of the votes of the directors present. The Board of Directors is responsible for: a) deliberating on the applications for admission of the members, b) drawing up the estimate and final report to be submitted to the Assembly, taking care of the ordinary administration, deliberating on the Treasurer's proposal the annual membership fees, c) setting the dates of Ordinary Shareholders' Meetings, d) planning the Assembly's activities respecting the Assembly's directives and the purposes of the association.

C) The President - Has the legal representation of the Association before third parties and in court. Oversees all activities with the association and takes care of relations with third parties. It convenes and presides over the Board of Directors and can delegate to other members of the same all or part of the powers. In case of his absence or impediment, his functions will be carried out by Vice - President. He is assisted in his work as Vice -

President, who is also appointed by the Board.

D) Vice President - The Vice President replaces the President in cases where he is temporarily prevented from performing his duties. He remains in office for 5 years and can be re-elected.

E) Treasurer - It keeps the income statement of the Association, on the basis of the directives given to it by the Board itself, taking care of the collection of membership fees, and prepares the budget of the Association.

Draw up the financial report, the final report. He remains in office for 5 years and can be re-elected.

Article 8 The corporate assets are made up of the annual fees paid by the members established annually by the Board of Directors, as well as contributions, donations, legacies and subsidies granted by public and private bodies or by private citizens. The social patrimony can not be destined to ends different from those statutorily own of the association.

Article 9 - The application for membership of the Association implies the unconditional acceptance of the present Statute.

Article 10 - The status of Member is lost by voluntary resignation, behavior contrary to the corporate purpose or deemed unacceptable by the Board of Directors, for arrearage if the member does not provide for the payment of the membership fee within 15 days of expiration, is understood to be excluded by law 'Association.

Article 11 - The social and financial year coincides with the calendar year. The budget, within 15 days of approval, will be deposited at the registered office in order to be consulted by ordinary members. The final balance must be approved by 31/03 of the following year.

Article 12 - If the need arises, an internal regulation may be drawn up by the

Board of Directors.

Article 13 - Any changes or additions to the present Statute must be approved by the Assembly with a simple majority of the members with voting rights. For the first five years the amendments to the Statute will be decided by the Board of Directors.

The changes must be approved unanimously.

F) Control Body - The Control Body, if elected, must be appointed by the Assembly, will remain in office for 5 years and may be re-elected. The tasks of this body are: a) to oversee the administration of the Association, b) to check the correspondence of the Financial Statements to the accounting records, c) to monitor compliance with the Articles of Association, e) to present its Annual Report on the Financial Statements.

Article 14 - The dissolution of the Association is approved by the Assembly of Members. The Assembly will have to deliberate on the destination of the possible active residue of the assets of the Association. The destination of the assets will be in favor of other associations with the same purpose.

Article 15 - The disputes that may arise between the Association and the Members, or among the Members themselves, will be donated to an arbitration board composed of three members who will judge ex-bono and fair as friendly composers and without procedural formalities. Each party in question names his representative in the College. The third will be chosen by mutual agreement.

Article 16 - For matters not provided for and regulated by this Statute, the provisions concerning the Civil Code and other provisions of the law in force in this regard apply.
